Subject: Public Statement

It has come to my attention that a video made on the 12th August 2025 by a Facebook and TikTok user by the name Mathew Onen Boss and Dnenjok respectively, is circulating on social media making false, misleading, and malicious allegations about the recent events in Kajo-keji and the Lotua's family.

The visit by the sons and daughters of Kajo-keji was to encourage and promote peace and unity among all communities of Kajo-keji, to encourage our brothers and sisters still in refugee settlements to return home and rebuild their lives and to recognize and commend the resilience, stability, and progress made under the current county leadership.

At no point during their visit did they engage in any activity or discussion that aligns with the false accusations being spread. The narrative being circulated is a deliberate distortion of the truth, intended to sow division and undermine the peace we have been working tirelessly to restore.

Additionally, it is worth noting that this was not their first time to visit Kajo-keji County. They have previously attended peace conferences here and have visited on many other occasions. I was personally present among them during this most recent visit.

I call upon all citizens of Kajo-keji and the wider public to disregard these false narratives and instead focus on unity, reconciliation, and development. Kajo-keji County remains committed to truth, transparency, and the service of its people.
